

## 2017-18 BQJBC U18 GRAND FINALS Information Sheet

Basketball Queensland would like to welcome all teams, family and friends, officials and members to Hibiscus Sports Complex for the 2017-18 BQJBC Under 18 Grand Finals.

<u>Parking & Entry</u> - The rear car park of the complex and the adjacent field will be available for parking. There is additional parking available at the Translink Park 'N' Ride located at the set of lights on Klumpp Road beside the complex.

Please note the front car park at Hibiscus will not be available to BQIBC Grand Final patrons.

Entry to the stadium will commence from 2:00pm. The entry fee to the Grand Finals is \$2 for an adult and \$1 for a child. Players and management of teams participating in a grand final will receive free entry. Upon paying your entry fee you will be given a wrist band which must be worn before entering the stadium.

<u>Photography & Video</u> - If you are bringing a camera or video recorder you must sign the register at the main entrance where you will be issued a pass to be placed on the device. Please note a team official must accompany and approve all persons registering to take photos or video of their game.

Photography & video will only be permitted from designated spectator areas and seating. Standing on sidelines and baselines for photography purposes is **not permitted** at any time. Photography/video from the team bench or score bench is also **not permitted**.

Please be aware Basketball Queensland may have their own professional photographer on site taking action shots from all games and presentations for future promotional use.

<u>Conditions of Entry and Codes of Conduct</u> - It is a condition of entry into the BQJBC Grand Finals that all Codes of Behaviour, including the BQ Zero Tolerance Policy, will be abided by. Codes of Behaviour are displayed around the stadium and these will be strictly enforced.

<u>Seating</u> - Court 1 has its own grandstand and can seat approximately 200 people. There will be limited seating available between courts 2 and 3. Additional seating is also available upstairs overlooking all courts.

Administration - The administration area can be located directly opposite the SWM canteen.

<u>First Aid</u> - The First Aid area can be located between courts 2 and 3 on the upper seating side of the stadium. Unless attending to an injury on court the First Aid Officer will be located in this position.

<u>Change Rooms</u> - There are four change rooms in the facility. Two will be designated for the girls and two for the boys. Change rooms are not lockable so nothing should be left in them.

<u>Water</u> - A tap can be found outside near the BBQ area (stadium exit beside the SWM canteen). South West Metro will also provide water coolers for teams alongside the benches.

<u>Canteen</u> - The canteen will be open all day and will close at the conclusion of the final games. No commercial quantities of food are permitted in the stadium, unless purchased from the Canteen. There is EFTPOS available for food and drink purchases.

<u>EFTPOS</u> - There is EFTPOS available at the SWM office to pay match fees, **however there is NO cash out**. The nearest ATM can be found in the Mt Gravatt Village Shopping Centre located on 1932 Logan Road (approximately 1km away).

<u>Presentations</u> - All teams are requested to immediately assemble on Court 1 at the conclusion of all games in their timeslot for presentations. On completion of the ceremony it is asked that everyone please leave the court area immediately to allow the following Grand Finals to get underway.

No food or drink is to be taken on court during presentations.
