#### Tournament Office

**Logan Metro** - Controller Room on ground floor (straight ahead upon venue entry opposite elevator)

**Cornubia Park** - office on the right of entry foyer (first door on the right as you enter venue, then first door on the right in hallway)

**Mt Warren** - Towards the end of the building opposite Court 4

#### Venue and Canteen Opening Hours

All venues will open one hour before first games tip off. There will be a canteen available at each venue whose operating hours will be the same as the game times.

#### Water Locations

**Logan Metro** - 1) Ground Floor - middle left of corridor; 2) First Floor - middle right of corridor. If there is no tap head please ask at the service desk.

**Cornubia Park** - 1) Reception area beside vending machines; 2) Downstairs corridor outside gym area

**Mt Warren** - 1) Outside entrance to court 4 - bottles only; 2) Canteen - for water containers

### **Spectators:**

Please note that spectators, including anyone wishing to take photo/video, **will not** be permitted onto the court areas at any venue. There are upper floor seating areas for Logan Metro and Cornubia Park for spectators and behind the glass and on the grandstand opposite Court 1 at Mt Warren.

Access to court areas at all venues is strictly for players, team staff, and event officials **only**.

### **Scoretable for Finals**

Basketball Queensland will provide the **full scoretable** in the following finals games for all divisions:

- Major Semi Finals (SF1 & SF2)
- Gold & Bronze Medal Games

Teams must provide their own competent scoretable personnel for all other games.

### **First Aid**

Sports Med & First Aid personnel for CBSQ is proudly provided by **Affordable Healing Hands**.

All personnel are minimum Level 2 qualified sports trainers and are experienced in sports strapping. Pricing for this service (payable by cash only) is as follows:

- \$5 for basic strapping
- \$6 for advanced strapping
- \$10 per roll of 38mm rigid tape
- \$15 per roll of Kinesio tape

Strapping is free if player provides their own tape.

Location of First Aid personnel:

**Logan Metro** – First Aid Room on ground floor adjacent to court 2

**Cornubia Park** – Located at access ramp to court level area

**Mt Warren** – In the corridor in front of court 3

### **CBSQ Conditions of Entry**

It is a condition of entry into all stadiums hosting the 2017 Champion Basketball School of Queensland Tournament that the:

- Basketball Queensland Codes of Behaviour,
- Basketball Queensland Zero Tolerance Policy, and
- all applicable venue policies & rules

will all be abided by.

Codes of Behaviour and Zero Tolerance Policy will be displayed at each venue and are also available any time from the Basketball Queensland website.

If at any time a person is found to be breaching any code they may be immediately removed from the venue by event staff and face further penalty under the Basketball Queensland Tribunal By-Laws, which will be enforced by the Tournament Technical Committee.

The Tournament Technical Committee also reserves the right to remove teams immediately from the tournament, and impose bans from future events, for any breach committed by that team's players, officials or spectators.

### **Photography and Video Taping**

Spectators who are wishing to take photo or video at the event must sign the Photo/Video Register at the Tournament Office upon entering the stadium where they will be issued with a photography pass. The spectator must be accompanied by a Team Official who is to sign and approve any person taking photos of their team.

Photo/video is only permitted to be taken from designated spectator seating areas. People **will not** be permitted in the court area to take a photo or video.

Personnel on scorebench, and players/officials on the team bench, **are not** permitted to take photos or video during games.

### **Responsibilities Regarding the Draw**

Team Managers are encouraged to check the draw right up to the start of the event for changes and every day during the course of the tournament. It is the Team Manager's responsibility to ensure their team is present and ready to play at their scheduled game time.

Event staff will make every endeavour to contact teams via a text messaging system to inform them of times for all crossover/playoff games. In instances of teams moving into a secondary pool the coach and/or manager will receive a text to advise of their new pool, pool number, and details of their first game only. The coach/manager is to then use this information and refer to the draw for all their remaining pool games.

Please note however that teams should not rely solely on text notification as this system is not always possible, and the **responsibility of ensuring the team is at their scheduled game on time will always remain with the team staff**. The order of preference for draw queries is as follows.

1. Check on the results board at the stadium as to where you finished on the ladder and see the Tournament Office staff if you need any points clarified
2. Check the ladder on the BQ website to see where you finished and then cross-reference this with the Official Draw
3. Check the Draws and Results section of the Basketball Queensland Website for updated draws
4. Call or text BQ Competitions Officer Iain McLennan on 0403 244 311

### **Team Bench Can and Can't Do's**

- Players and official team staff are the **ONLY** persons permitted within the bench area.
- Either the coach or the assistant coach, **but only one of them at any given time**, is permitted to stand during the game. They may address the players verbally during the game provided they remain within their team bench area. Only during time-outs can the coaches can enter the playing area to address their team provided they are close to the team bench area.
- Players must remain seated at **all times**.
- Only the coach or assistant coach may approach the scoretable to request a time-out
- The coach and the assistant coach may go to the scoretable during the game to obtain statistical information only when the ball becomes dead and the game clock is stopped.
- **Only the head coach can talk to the referees**; and always in a courteous manner and under no circumstances should they enter the playing area to do this.
- The captain may talk to the referees during intervals of play to clarify rule interpretations. When the captain leaves the playing court the coach shall inform an official of the number of the player who will act as captain on the playing court.
