



2017-18 BQJBC U16 and U21M GRAND FINALS Information Sheet

Basketball Queensland would like to welcome all teams, family and friends, officials and members to NAB Stadium for the 2017-18 BQJBC Under 16 and U21 Men's Grand Finals.

Parking & Entry - Car parking is available within the venue for a limited number of vehicles and for the excess on street parking.

Entry to the stadium will commence from 1:00pm.

Photography & Video - If you are bringing a camera or video recorder you must sign the register at the main entrance where you will be issued a pass to be placed on the device. Please note a team official must accompany and approve all persons registering to take photos or video of their game.

Photography & video will only be permitted from designated spectator areas and seating. Standing on sidelines and baselines for photography purposes is **not permitted** at any time. Photography/video from the team bench or score bench is also **not permitted**.

Please be aware Basketball Queensland may have their own professional photographer on site taking action shots from all games and presentations for future promotional use.

Conditions of Entry and Codes of Conduct - It is a condition of entry into the BQJBC Grand Finals that all Codes of Behaviour, including the BQ Zero Tolerance Policy, will be abided by. Codes of Behaviour are displayed around the stadium and these will be strictly enforced.

Seating - Court 1 has its own grandstand and can seat approximately 450 people. There will be limited seating available on the other courts (3 and 4).

Administration - The administration area can be located at the main entry.

First Aid - The First Aid area can be located in the foyer at the foot of the stairs to court 1 and 2. This is where you will find First Aid support.

Change Rooms - There are four change rooms throughout the facility. Change rooms are not lockable so nothing should be left in them.

Water - A tap can be found outside the entry with the tap available from Games Reception administration.

Canteen - The canteen will be open all day and will close at the conclusion of the final games. No commercial quantities of food are permitted in the stadium, unless purchased from the Canteen. There is EFTPOS available for food and drink purchases - minimum purchase \$5

EFTPOS - There is EFTPOS available at games reception administration to pay match fees, **cash out is available with a \$1 transaction fee**. The nearest ATM can be found at the Toowong Shopping centre (approximately 1km away).

Presentations - All teams are requested to immediately assemble on Court 1 at the conclusion of all games in their timeslot for presentations. On completion of the ceremony it is asked that everyone please leave the court area immediately to allow the following Grand Finals to get underway.

No food or drink is to be taken on court during presentations.
